KNOW YOUR FINISH

Different materials. different care. Identify your finish and follow the recommended guidelines below.

ROUTINE CLEANING

- * Use soft microfiber cloth
- * Clean with mild soap
- * Wipe surfaces dry

MAINTENANCE

- * Clean spills quickly
- * Keep surfaces dry
- * Use cabinet handles

DO NOT USE

- * Abrasive scrub pads
- * Harsh chemical cleaners
- * Excessive moisture

Painted Shaker/Flat



ROUTINE CLEANING

- * Dust regularly
- * Use soft microfiber cloth

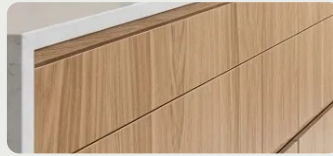
MAINTENANCE

- * Dry surfaces immediately
- * Preferably, avoid direct sunlight

DO NOT USE

- * Bleach or ammonia
- * Abrasive cleaners
- * Sharp objects

ROUTINE CLEANING

- * Use soft microfiber cloth
- * Wipe surfaces dry

MAINTENANCE

- * Control indoor humidity
- * Clean spills immediately
- * Preferably, avoid direct sunlight

DO NOT USE

- * Excess water
- * Harsh solvents
- * Abrasive pads

Vinyl Wrap



ROUTINE CLEANING

- * Clean with mild soap
- * Use soft microfiber cloth

MAINTENANCE

- * Keep surfaces dry
- * Clean spill immediately

DO NOT USE

- * Harsh chemical cleaners
- * Excessive heat and steam
- * Abrasive scrub pads

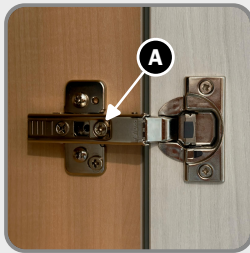
SIMPLE ADJUSTMENTS YOU CAN DO

> DOOR ADJUSTMENTS (if the door is not aligned)



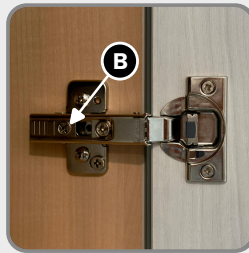
A) SIDE TO SIDE:

Turn the screw closest to the door (see letter A).



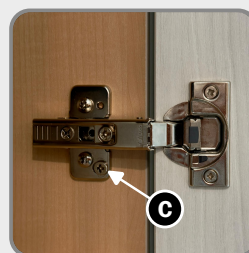
B) IN & OUT:

Turn the front screw to adjust the gap (see letter B).



C) UP & DOWN:

Turn the bottom screw (see letter C).

> DRAWER ADJUSTMENTS (if the drawer front is not aligned)



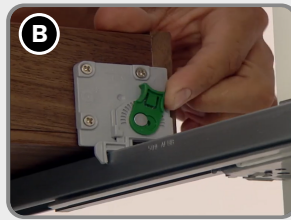
A) UP & DOWN:

Slide the plastic piece under the drawer forward or backward for vertical adjustment.



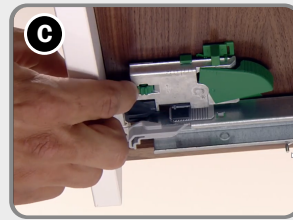
B) FRONT TILTING:

Move left or right the system on the back of the drawer, for front drawer tilting.



C) SIDE GAP:

Scroll both buttons under the drawer at the same time to adjust the horizontal gap.
